

 - brain primary registers of public administration





MINISTERSTVO VNITRA CUrrent state in public administration



- fragmentation of data in most registers
- o duplicated data in public registers
- o citizens have to repeatedly provide the same data to different authorities
- o low effectivity in re-using the data in public registers



Future vision



- citizens will no longer repeatedly provide the same data to different authorities
- all authorities will have an access to the most accurate and up-to-date data
- the most frequently used data in the public administration will be shared from one source




Solution BASIC REGISTERS



- four central basic registers as a reliable source of the most frequently used data in the public administration
- aim: to share the data among public authorities in a safe and controlled manner via information system of basic registers
- o reference data in basic registers will be shared as accurate and up-to-date

Basic registers







BASIC REGISTERS overview



- register of inhabitants
- o register of persons
- register of territorial identification, addresses and real estates property
- register of rights and duties



e-Identity



- a unique basic identifier of natural persons (BINP)
- from BINP will be generated for natural persons unique identifier to every registered agenda or evidence
- reducing the possibility of abusing of personal reference data



Personal Data Protection



- electronic identity offers the possibility to significantly improve the level of protection of citizen's privacy
- generation of special identifier of natural persons (BINP) will be supervised by The Office for Personal Data Protection
- authorized access of users will ensure that only competent authorities will be able to use personal reference data



Legal aspects



- Basic register Act
 - described process of re-using of reference data
 - definition of information system of basic registers
 - definition of basic registers and reference data
 - all basic register will be regulated by this Act
 - expected to come into effect 01.07.2010
