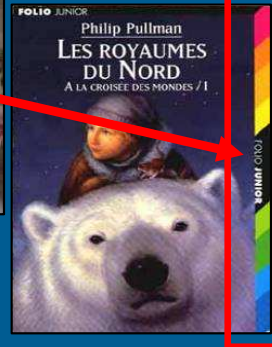


# INTERPOL Child Abuse Image Database (ICAID)

Picture analysis



- **Child Abuse Images:**
  - In 2001 – 50,000 Images
  - In March 2009 - 549,030 Images
- **Identified and Rescued Child Victims**
  - In 2001 – 30 victims
  - March 2009 - 890 victims from 37 countries



# International Child Sexual Exploitation Image Database (ICSE)

INTERPOL

- **Funded by G-8 Member countries and Norway**
- **ICSE allows experts to carry out their own checks and comparisons of child sexual abuse images against INTERPOL's global database**
- **Operational since March 2009 in six countries:**
  - **Canada**
  - **Denmark**
  - **Germany**
  - **Norway**
  - **Sweden**
  - **United Kingdom**
- **15-20 countries connected by end of 2009**
- **Active Support from the European Union (EU) for the immediate expansion of the database**

Before distribution, the suspect digitally edited the pictures so that his face could not be recognized. Pictures which have not been digitally edited have now been found in another Norwegian case. Based on his skin colour, physique, clothing and head-shape, the suspect is believed to be of European or North American origin. He is believed to be between 45 and 65 years old.

1.19 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The pictures show the suspect sexually abusing children.

2. INFORMATION RELATED TO THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION

2.1 SUMMARY OF FACTS OF THE CASE: The sexual violence section of the National Criminal Investigation Service in Norway (KRIPOS) is currently conducting investigations in order to identify the suspect and the victims of a recently discovered series of child pornographic pictures (the working title of which is Thai Luv) showing a single adult male sexually abusing several boys at different locations. At this stage of the investigation it is assumed that there are several different victims, all young. The abuse is thought to have taken place in South-East Asia, most probably in Thailand, and the victims are likely to be of South-East Asian origin. The pictures were first seen by our office in
