** **Total number of decisions** = this column contains not only sum of positive, negative and terminating decisions but also self-corrective and other, mostly exceptional, decisions taken by the first instance

*** **Served decisions** = this column also contains older decisions which were served on international protection seekers during the given period. After being served with the decision the person stops being an international protection seeker in the First Instance of the Asylum Procedure.
