

### **3. RECOMMENDATION FROM THE MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC FOR BRITISH CITIZENS IN CONNECTION WITH BREXIT**

In a view of the planned withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (the UK) from the European Union at 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019, the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic reminds its earlier recommendations and, for reasons of legal certainty, time-saving and avoidance of possible more complicated administrative procedures in the future, **calls on UK citizens living in the Czech Republic to:**

- **apply for a Certificate of Temporary Residence if they intend to stay in the country for more than three months** (for further information visit <https://www.mvcr.cz/mvcren/article/eu-citizens-and-their-family-members.aspx>)
