

2. RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC FOR BRITISH CITIZENS IN CONNECTION WITH BREXIT

For reasons of legal certainty and to save time and avoid possible more complicated administrative procedures in the future, the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic **recommends that all UK citizens who reside in the Czech Republic:**

- > **apply for a Certificate of Temporary Residence** if they intend to stay in the country for more than three months (for further information visit <https://www.mvcr.cz/mvcren/article/eu-citizens-and-their-family-members.aspx>)

- > **apply for a Permanent Residence Permit** if they have lived in the country for more than five years (for further information visit <https://www.mvcr.cz/mvcren/article/eu-citizens-and-their-family-members-permanent-residence.aspx>).

Negotiations on future relations between the European Union and the United Kingdom are still ongoing. Nonetheless, residence registration in the Czech Republic is very important for ensuring residency in the case of any scenario. The Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic will continue to keep UK citizens informed of any further developments.
